- Operational non-motorized and motorized user accommodation gaps at interchanges

**The next step will be to identify solutions to address these needs within the available funding to make this area safer for everyone.**



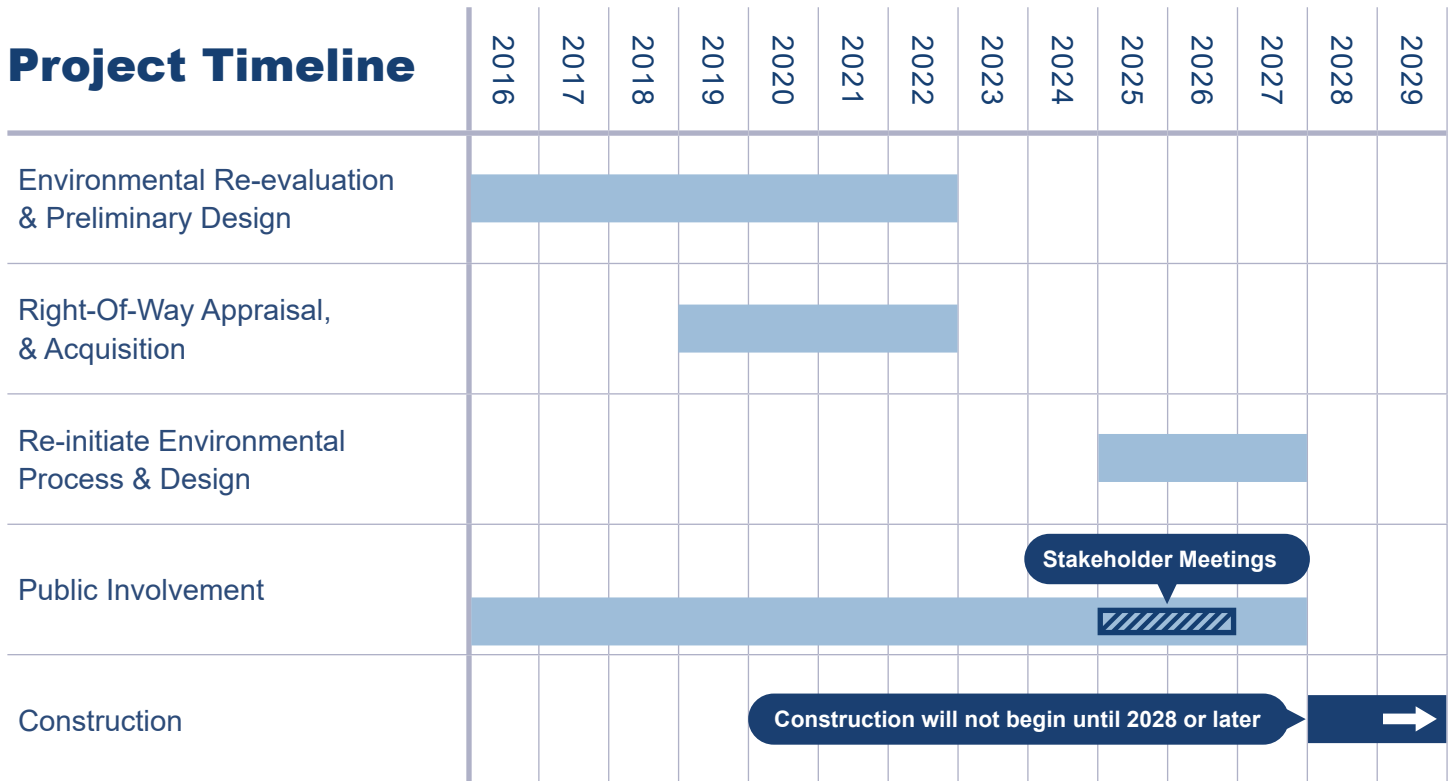
